SUBJECT: India Country Operational Plan 2014 Approval

#### Recommendation

That you approve the India Country Operational Plan (COP) 2014 with a total spend of \$28,000,000 to achieve the targets listed in this memo, below. The FY 2014 funds are broken down as follows:

- New FY 2014 Funds: \$15,766,037 (all accounts, including Pre-COP);
- Prior Year Funds (Applied Pipeline Funds): \$12,233,963 (approved for COP 14 implementation).

The total amount spent (outlayed) during the 12 months of FY 2014 COP implementation will not exceed the total approved amount of \$28,000,000.

Approved funding will be transferred to agency headquarters for allocation to country as outlined below.
