SUBJECT: Malawi Country Operational Plan 2014 Approval

**Recommendation**

That you approve the Malawi Country Operational Plan (COP) 2014 with a total spend of \$85,000,000 to achieve the targets listed in this memo, below. The FY 2014 funds are broken down as follows:

- New FY 2014 Funds: \$81,192,327 (all accounts, including Pre-COP); and
- Applied Pipeline Funds: \$3,807,673 (approved for COP 2014 implementation)

It is expected that the total amount spent (outlaid) during the 12 months of FY 2015 implementation will not exceed the total approved amount.

Approved funding will be transferred to agency headquarters for allocation to country as outlined below.

**Applied Pipeline Funds: \$3,807,674**

Upon receipt of this signed memo, respective agencies may immediately begin using the prior year funds as applied pipeline to fund approved activities, as outlined in the COP.
