### **Principal Deputy Director of the Office of Foreign Missions**

The Department of State is pleased to announce the permanent assignment of Cliff Seagroves as the Principal Deputy Director of the Office of Foreign Missions (OFM). This position is equivalent to that of a Principal Deputy Assistant Secretary of State.

As OFM's Principal Deputy Director, Mr. Seagroves is responsible for the day-to-day operations of the organization, which include undertaking the Secretary of State's obligations under the Foreign Missions Act. In doing so, Mr. Seagroves oversees the development and implementation of policies associated with the establishment and operation of over 2,000 foreign missions in the United States and ensures the Department of State's proper extension of privileges and immunities to over 100,000 employees and family members assigned to such missions.

Mr. Seagroves is a member of the Senior Executive Service and has served in multiple roles within OFM since he began his career with the Department of State in 2002. Such roles included service as OFM's acting Director and from 2010 to April 2020 as the Assistant Director for Policy and Reciprocity.

Mr. Seagroves earned a Master of Public Administration degree from North Carolina Central University and Bachelor of Arts Degree in Communication from East Carolina University. He also holds a Certificate of Achievement in Russian Media Studies from St. Petersburg State University in St. Petersburg, Russia.
