### **Reopening of Maine (COVID-19)**

The Governor of Maine has prepared a reopening plan for the State, that took effect on May 1, 2020. The guiding principles behind the reopening include protecting public health, maintaining health care readiness, capability of reliable and accessible testing and the importance of prioritizing public-private collaboration.

The plan, informed by several health metrics and capacities, will be a monthly staged approach and is advanced as a framework for planning.
