



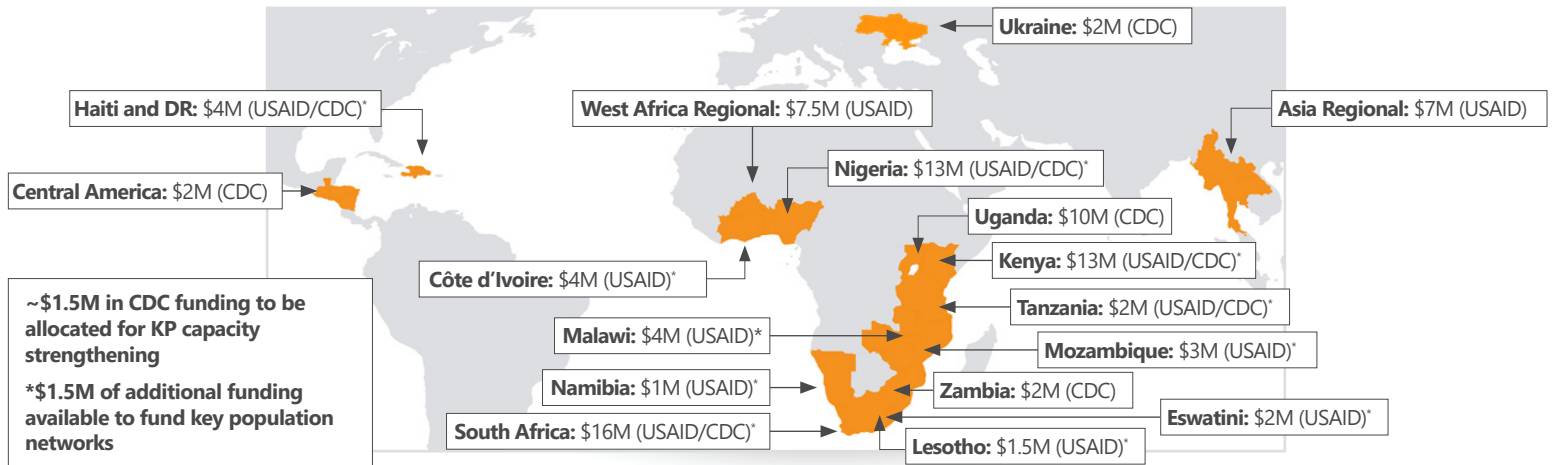

### The \$100 million Key Populations Investment Fund supports the expansion of quality HIV services for key populations

The Key Populations Investment Fund (KPIF) is PEPFAR's \$100 million initiative to expand key populations' (KP) access to and retention in HIV prevention and treatment services. The KPIF includes funding for indigenous, community-based KP-led, KP-trusted, and KP-competent organizations. KPIF focuses on specific KP, including men who have sex with men, sex workers, transgender individuals, and people who inject drugs.



### Core elements of the KPIF:

	Increase KP testing coverage and HIV case finding		Implement Undetectable=Untransmittable (U=U) messaging to emphasize the power of adherence to ART and reduce stigma
	Scale pre-exposure prophylaxis (PrEP) delivery		Strengthen capacity of KP-led local organizations to provide community-focused services
	Enroll more KP on antiretroviral treatment (ART)		Monitor results in real-time
	Retain KP on ART and achieve viral load suppression		Measure and report KPIF-specific impact on operational unit-level efforts to control the HIV epidemic
	Address specific structural barriers that inhibit access to/effectiveness of HIV services		Regular engagement with KP-led, trusted, and competent organizations and other civil society organizations at both the local and global levels throughout the implementation of the KPIF.
