NOTE BY THE DEPARTMENT OF STATE

Pursuant to Public Law 89—497, approved July 8, 1966
(80 Stat. 271; 1 U.S.C. 113)—

“ . . .the Treaties and Other International Acts Series issued under the authority of the Secretary of State shall be competent evidence . . . of the treaties, international agreements other than treaties, and proclamations by the President of such treaties and international agreements other than treaties, as the case may be, therein contained, in all the courts of law and equity and of maritime jurisdiction, and in all the tribunals and public offices of the United States, and of the several States, without any further proof or authentication thereof.”

AGREEMENT EXTENDING THE ARRANGEMENT
BETWEEN
THE UNITED STATES NUCLEAR REGULATORY COMMISSION
AND
THE EUROPEAN ATOMIC ENERGY COMMUNITY
FOR THE EXCHANGE OF TECHNICAL INFORMATION AND
COOPERATION IN NUCLEAR SAFETY MATTERS

The United States Nuclear Regulatory Commission and the European Atomic Energy Community, the two together hereinafter referred to as "the Parties";

Recalling the Arrangement between the United States Nuclear Regulatory Commission (USNRC) and the European Atomic Energy Community (EURATOM), Represented by the European Commission, for the Exchange of Technical Information and Cooperation in Nuclear Safety Matters, signed at Vienna, Austria, on September 15, 2015 (the "Arrangement");

Guided by their desire to continue cooperation under the Arrangement; and

Recalling that, as envisaged by Section IV.D of the Arrangement, the Arrangement may be extended by written agreement of the Parties,

Hereby agree as follows:

1. The Arrangement shall be extended for a period of 1 year, from September 15, 2020, to September 15, 2021.

2. This Agreement shall enter into force upon the signature of both Parties with effect from September 15, 2020.


