NOTE BY THE DEPARTMENT OF STATE

Pursuant to Public Law 89—497, approved July 8, 1966
(80 Stat. 271; 1 U.S.C. 113)—

“ . . .the Treaties and Other International Acts Series issued under the authority of the Secretary of State shall be competent evidence . . . of the treaties, international agreements other than treaties, and proclamations by the President of such treaties and international agreements other than treaties, as the case may be, therein contained, in all the courts of law and equity and of maritime jurisdiction, and in all the tribunals and public offices of the United States, and of the several States, without any further proof or authentication thereof.”

**Agreement to Extend the Framework Agreement between
the National Aeronautics and Space Administration
and the German Aerospace Center
On Cooperation in Aeronautics and the Exploration and
Use of Outer Space for Peaceful Purposes**

The National Aeronautics and Space Administration (NASA) and the German Aerospace Center (DLR);

Desiring to continue their successful cooperation under the Framework Agreement between the National Aeronautics and Space Administration and the German Aerospace Center on Cooperation in Aeronautics and the Exploration and Use of Outer Space for Peaceful Purposes that entered into force on December 13, 2010 (hereinafter referred to as the "Framework Agreement");


Noting that the original duration of the Framework Agreement is ten (10) years, until December 13, 2020, and that the Parties may extend the Framework Agreement by mutual written agreement in accordance with Article 16 of the Framework Agreement;

Have agreed as follows:

The Framework Agreement shall be extended for ten additional years until December 13, 2030. This Agreement shall enter into force on the date of last signature by the Parties, with effect from December 13, 2020.
