### **Tropical Depression Ida**

Tropical Depression Ida is forecast to bring heavy rain and possibly damaging winds to Washington, DC starting at noon on Wednesday, September 1, 2021. The National Weather Service (NWS) estimates that Washington, DC could see anywhere from 3 to 5 inches of rain, downed trees, and possible flash flooding.

Foreign Missions should make necessary arrangements for staff in the Washington, DC area and have up to date contact information to reach them prior, during, and following the storm.
