**Convention Providing a Uniform Law on the Form of an International Will**

Done at Washington on October 26, 1973

Canada: Declaration

Date of Action: July 6, 2021

The Secretary of State, in performance of the depositary duties of the United States of America, communicates the following:

On July 6, 2021, Canada deposited a declaration by the Minister of Foreign Affairs of Canada extending to the territory of Yukon the Convention Providing a Uniform Law on the Form of an International Will, in accordance with Article XIV of the Convention.

The declaration states: "All members of the Law Society of Yukon are designated as persons authorized to act in connection with international wills, in accordance with Article II of the Convention."

The declaration was transmitted under cover of a diplomatic note from the Embassy of Canada, which states Canada's understanding that the declaration will take effect six months after the deposit of the diplomatic note, on January 6, 2022.
