Effectuated by Exchange of Notes at Athens
January 5, 2022 and January 11, 2022
Entered into force January 11, 2022



NOTE BY THE DEPARTMENT OF STATE

Pursuant to Public Law 89—497, approved July 8, 1966
(80 Stat. 271; 1 U.S.C. 113)—

“ . . .the Treaties and Other International Acts Series issued under the authority of the Secretary of State shall be competent evidence . . . of the treaties, international agreements other than treaties, and proclamations by the President of such treaties and international agreements other than treaties, as the case may be, therein contained, in all the courts of law and equity and of maritime jurisdiction, and in all the tribunals and public offices of the United States, and of the several States, without any further proof or authentication thereof.”

In connection with these discussions, the Embassy proposes that the Government of the United States of America and the Government of the Hellenic Republic agree that, unless the consent of the Government of the United States of America has first been obtained, the Government of the Hellenic Republic shall not provide any assistance furnished by the United States of America under the Foreign Assistance Act of 1961 or the Arms Export Control Act, or successor legislation, to any security force unit of the Hellenic Republic that the Government of the United States of America has identified to the Government of the Hellenic Republic via diplomatic channels as prohibited from receiving such assistance under section 620M of the Foreign Assistance Act of 1961, also known as the Leahy law.

If the foregoing proposal is acceptable to the Government of the Hellenic Republic, the Embassy proposes that this note and the Ministry of Foreign Affairs' note confirming acceptance of the foregoing proposal shall constitute an agreement between the Government of the Hellenic Republic and the Government of the United States of America, which shall enter into force on the date of the Ministry's note. The Government of the United States of America and the Government of the Hellenic Republic may amend such agreement in writing. Such agreement may be terminated at any time by either Government upon ninety (90) days' prior written notice to the other Government.

The Embassy of the United States of America avails itself of this occasion to renew to the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of the Hellenic Republic the assurances of its highest consideration.

VERBAL NOTE

The Ministry of Foreign Affairs of the Hellenic Republic presents its compliments to the Embassy of the United States of America and wishes to refer to the latter's Verbal Note No 003/POL/2022, dated January 5, 2022, which reads as follows:

"The Embassy of the United States of America presents its compliments to the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of the Hellenic Republic and has the honor to refer to earlier discussions between representatives of the Government of the United States of America and the Government of the Hellenic Republic regarding assistance furnished on a grant basis under the Foreign Assistance Act of 1961 and the Arms Export Control Act, or successor legislation, from the United States of America to the Hellenic Republic.

In connection with these discussions, the Embassy proposes that the Government of the United States of America and the Government of the Hellenic Republic agree that, unless the consent of the Government of the United States of America has first been obtained, the Government of the Hellenic Republic shall not provide any assistance furnished by the United States of America under the Foreign Assistance Act of 1961 or the Arms Export Control Act, or successor legislation, to any security force unit of the Hellenic Republic that the Government of the United States of America has identified to the Government of the Hellenic Republic via diplomatic channels as prohibited from receiving such assistance under section 620M of the Foreign Assistance Act of 1961, also known as the Leahy law.



The Government of the United States of America and the Government of the Hellenic Republic may amend such agreement in writing. Such agreement may be terminated at any time by either Government upon ninety (90) days' prior written notice to the other Government.

The Embassy of the United States of America avails itself of this occasion to renew to the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of the Hellenic Republic the assurances of its highest consideration."

The Ministry of Foreign Affairs of the Hellenic Republic has the honor to confirm that the proposal contained in the Embassy of the United States of America's note No. 003/POL/2022, dated January 5, 2022, is acceptable to the Government of the Hellenic Republic and that the above Note from the Embassy of the United States of America and this reply thereto shall constitute an agreement between the Government of the Hellenic Republic and the Government of the United States of America, which shall enter into force on the date of this Note. The Ministry of Foreign Affairs further confirms the Government of the Hellenic Republic's acceptance that the Government of the United States of America and the Government of the Hellenic Republic may amend such agreement in writing and such agreement may be terminated at any time by either Government upon ninety (90) days' prior written notice to the other Government.

The Ministry of Foreign Affairs avails itself of this opportunity to renew to the Embassy of the United States of America the assurances of its highest consideration.
