Hurricane Fiona

Hurricane Fiona severely affected the island of Puerto Rico on Sunday, September 18, 2022. The U.S. National Hurricane Center has indicated that Fiona's these rains will produce life-threatening and catastrophic flash and urban flooding across Puerto Rico and the eastern Dominican Republic, along with mudslides and landslides in areas of higher terrain. Federal officials are working with Puerto Rican officials on the ground and will support restoration efforts as soon as it's safe to do so and understand that the major power outages are being reported making communication with Puerto Rico challenging

To date, there have been no reports of foreign nationals impacted.
