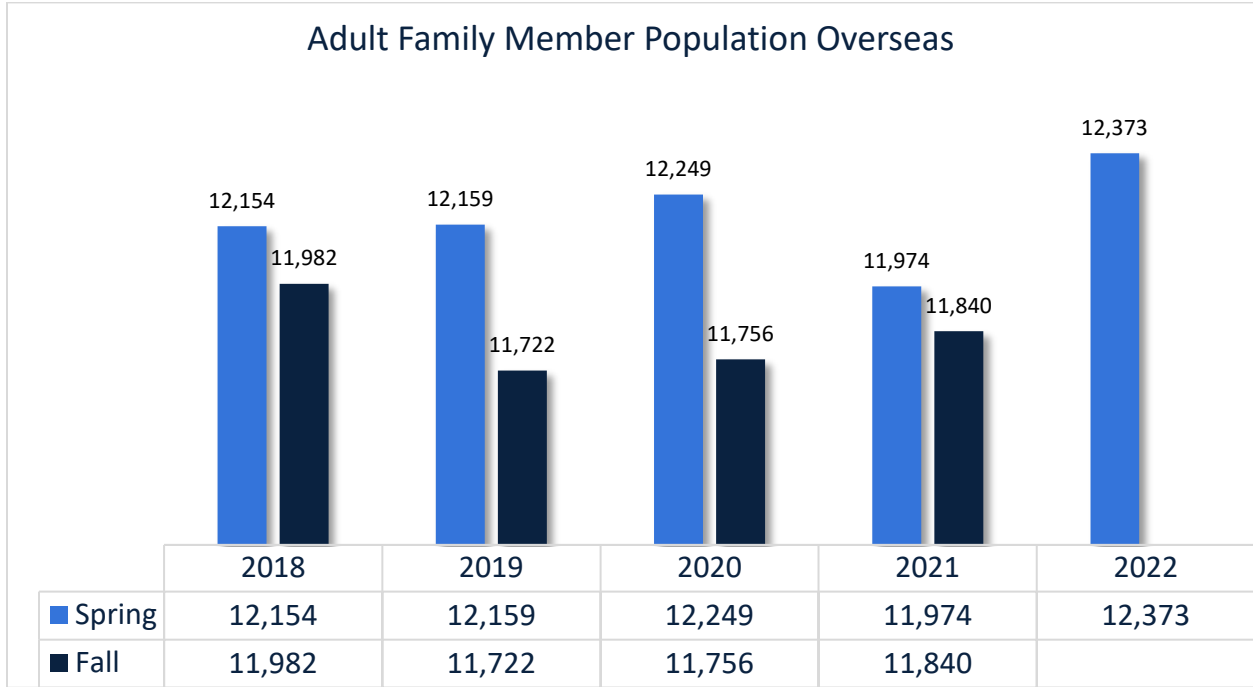

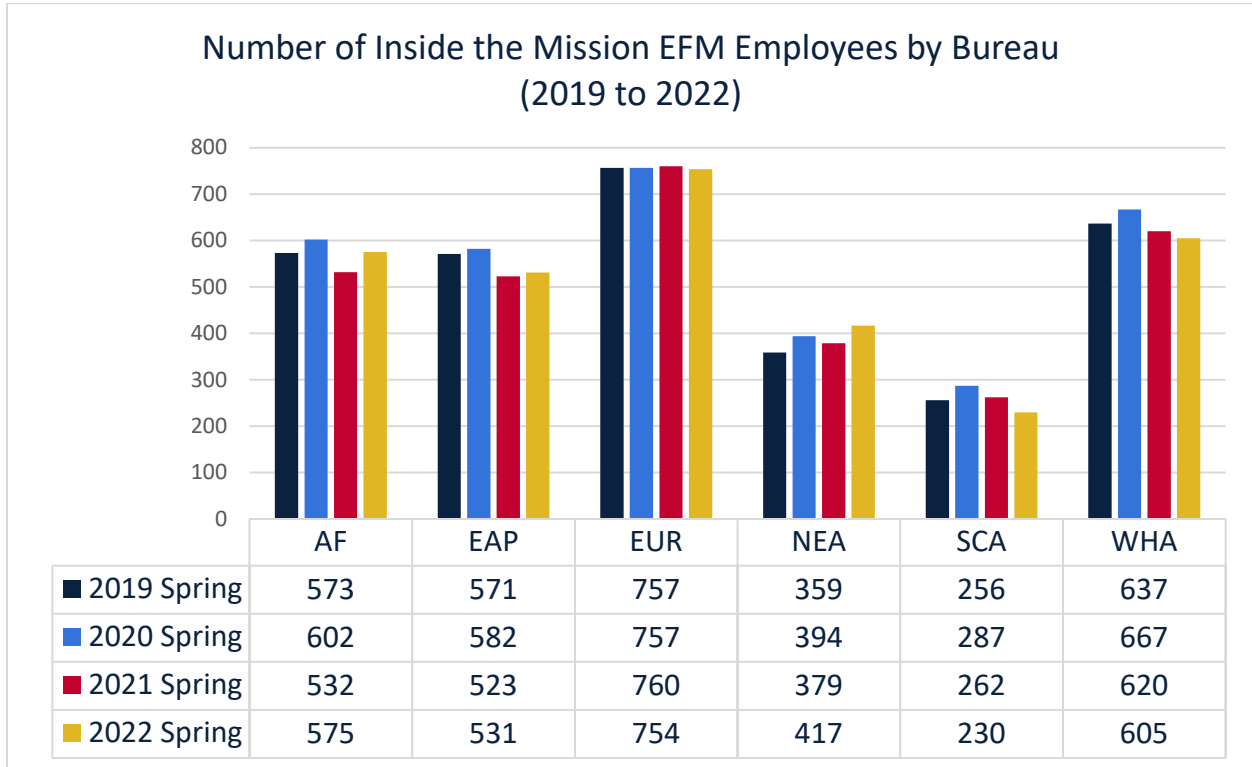

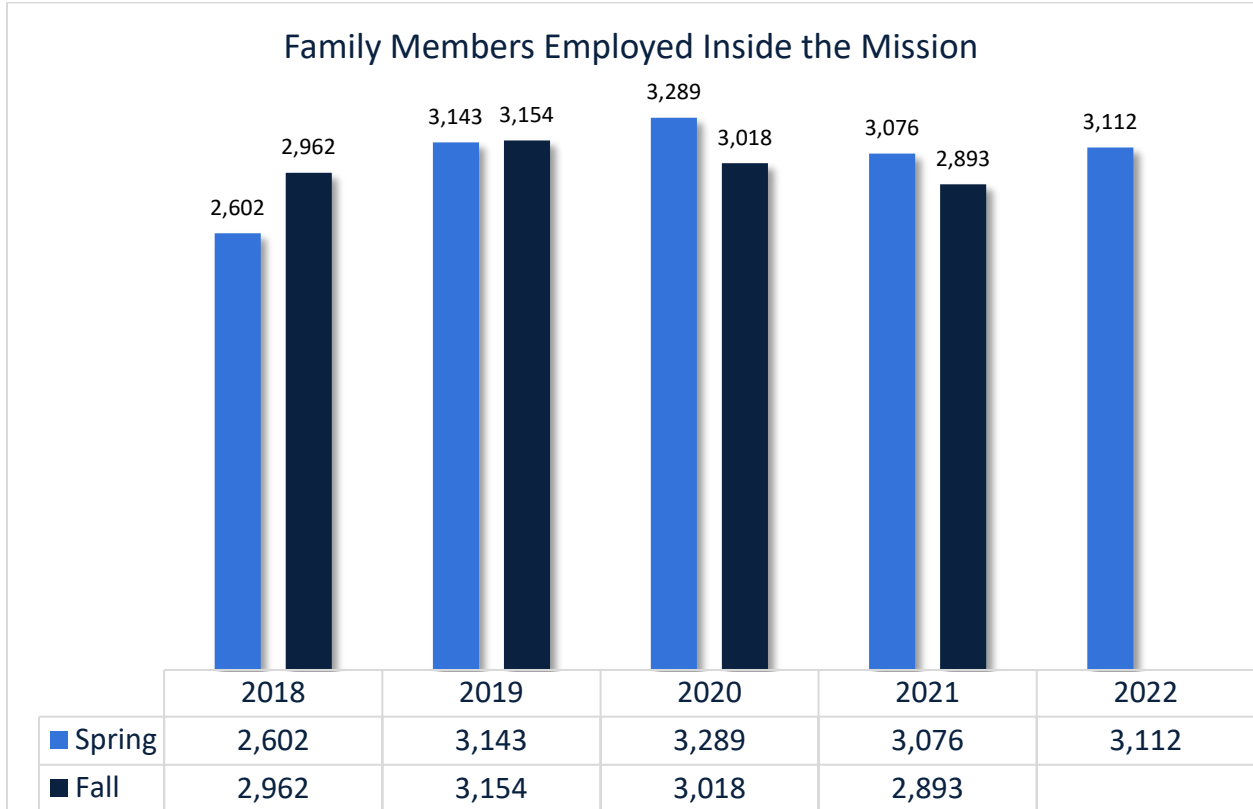


Number of Inside the Mission EFM Employees by Bureau (Spring 2019 - 2022)

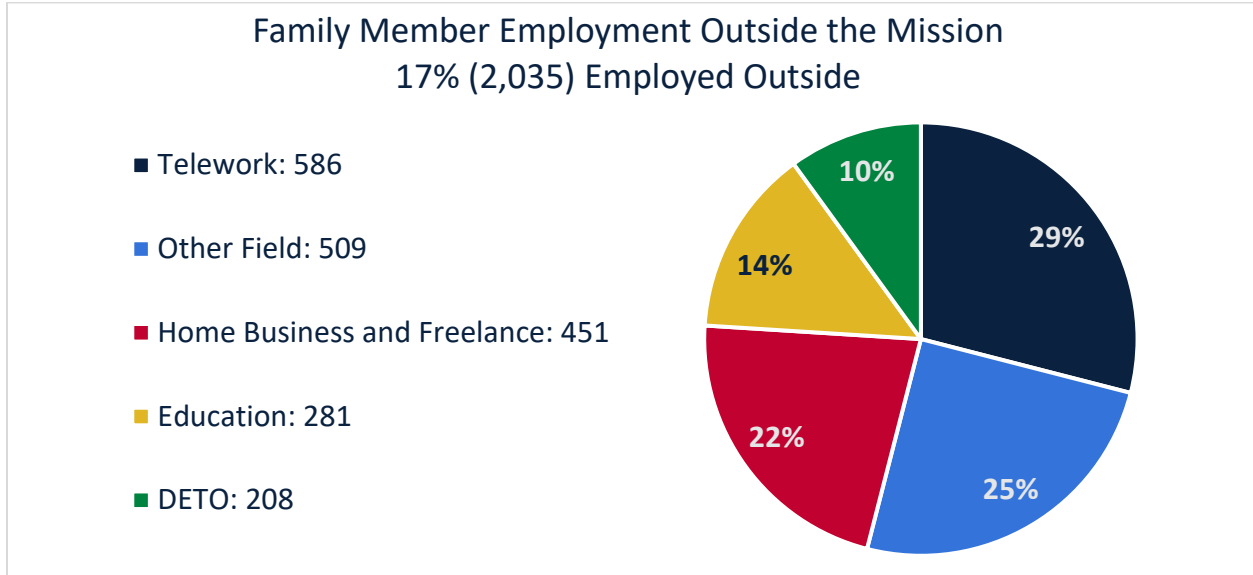
