**Agreement Between the
UNITED STATES OF AMERICA
and EGYPT**

Effectuated by Exchange of Notes at Cairo December 30, 2021

Entered into force April 12, 2023



NOTE BY THE DEPARTMENT OF STATE

Pursuant to Public Law 89—497, approved July 8, 1966
(80 Stat. 271; 1 U.S.C. 113)—

“ . . .the Treaties and Other International Acts Series issued under the authority of the Secretary of State shall be competent evidence . . . of the treaties, international agreements other than treaties, and proclamations by the President of such treaties and international agreements other than treaties, as the case may be, therein contained, in all the courts of law and equity and of maritime jurisdiction, and in all the tribunals and public offices of the United States, and of the several States, without any further proof or authentication thereof.”

The Embassy of the United States of America presents its compliments to the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of the Arab Republic of Egypt, Office of the Assistant Foreign Minister for Americas Affairs, and has the honor to refer to earlier discussions between representatives of the Government of the United States of America and the Government of the Arab Republic of Egypt regarding assistance furnished on a grant basis under the Foreign Assistance Act of 1961 and the Arms Export Control Act, or successor legislation, from the United States of America to the Arab Republic of Egypt.

In connection with these discussions, the Embassy proposes that the Government of the United States of America and the Government of Egypt agree that, unless the consent of the Government of the United States of America has first been obtained, the Government of Egypt shall not provide any assistance furnished by the United States of America under the Foreign Assistance Act of 1961 or the Arms Export Control Act, or successor legislation, to any security force unit of Egypt that the Government of the United States of America has identified to Egypt via diplomatic channels as prohibited from receiving such assistance under section 620M of the Foreign Assistance Act of 1961, also known as the Leahy law.

If the foregoing proposal is acceptable to the Government of Egypt, the Embassy proposes that the Ministry of Foreign Affairs' note to that effect and this note shall constitute an agreement between the Government of Egypt and the

Government of the United States of America. This agreement shall enter into force on the date of the last note in an exchange of notes between the governments indicating that all necessary domestic procedures have been completed to bring the agreement into force. The Government of the United States of America and the Government of Egypt may amend such agreement in writing. Such agreement may be terminated at any time by either Government upon ninety (90) days' prior written notice to the other Government.

The Embassy of the United States of America avails itself of this opportunity to renew with the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of the Arab Republic of Egypt the assurances of its highest consideration.

“The Embassy of the United States of America presents its compliments to the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of the Arab Republic of Egypt, Office of the Assistant Foreign Minister for Americas Affairs, and has the honor to refer to earlier discussions between representatives of the Government of the United States of America and the Government of the Arab Republic of Egypt regarding assistance furnished on a grant basis under the Foreign Assistance Act of 1961 and the Arms Export Control Act, or successor legislation, from the United States of America to the Arab Republic of Egypt.

In connection with these discussions, the Embassy proposes that the Government of the United States of America and the Government of Egypt agree that, unless the consent of the Government of the United States of America has first been obtained, the Government of Egypt shall not provide any assistance furnished by the United States of America under the Foreign Assistance Act of 1961 or the Arms Export Control Act or successor legislation, to any security force unit of Egypt that the Government of the United States of America has identified to Egypt via diplomatic channels as prohibited from receiving such assistance under section 620M of the Foreign Assistance Act of 1961, also known as the Leahy law.

If the foregoing proposal is acceptable to the Government of Egypt, the Embassy proposes that the Ministry of Foreign Affairs' note to that effect and this note shall constitute an agreement between the Government of Egypt and the Government of the United States of America. This agreement shall enter into force on the date of the last note in an exchange of notes between the Governments indicating that all necessary domestic procedures have been completed to bring the agreement into force. The Government of the United States and the Government of Egypt may amend such agreement in writing. This agreement shall enter into force on the date of the last note in an exchange of notes between the Governments indicating that all necessary domestic procedures have been completed to bring the agreement into force.
