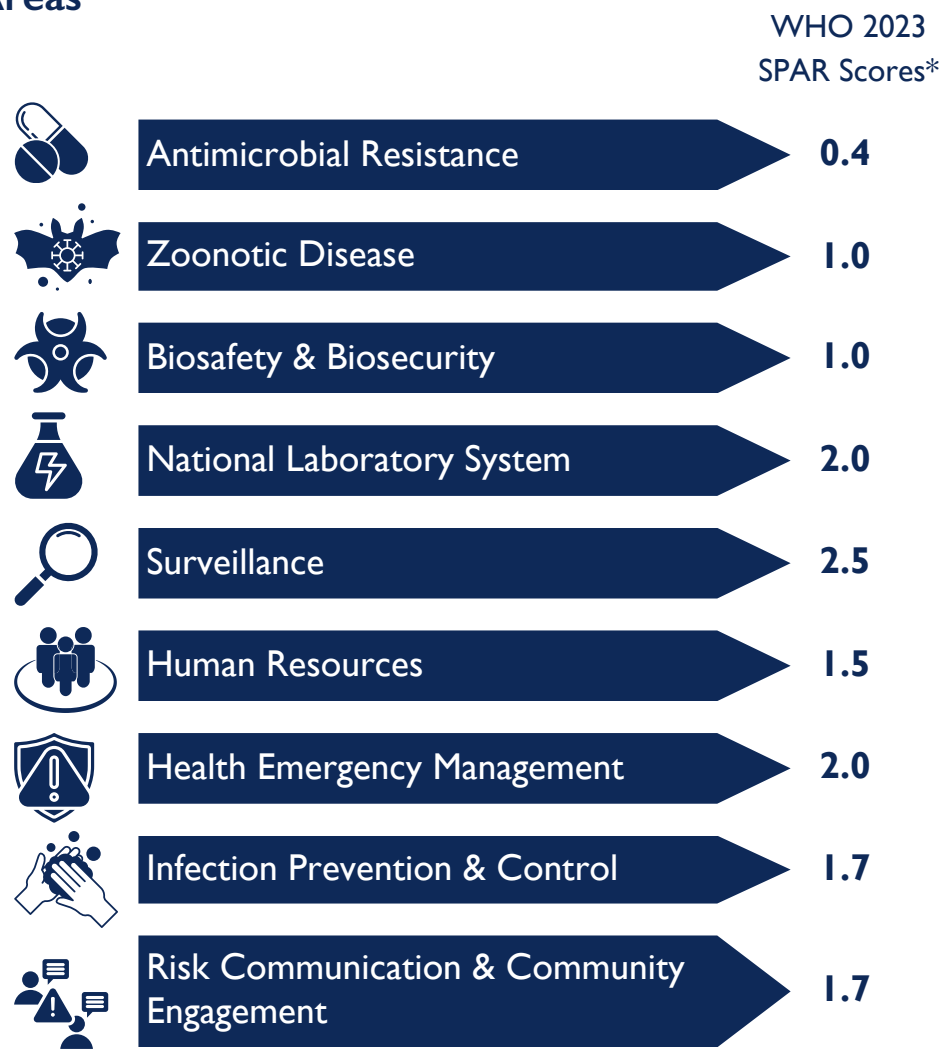


BURUNDI

* The World Health Organization (WHO) States Parties Annual Report (SPAR) is a publicly available self-assessment by the government of its global health security capacities. Scores presented here are based on a 5-point scale. Biosafety & Biosecurity score presented separately from National Laboratory System score. Antimicrobial Resistance uses [2021 Global Health Security Index](#) score as it is not included in the SPAR.



The U.S. has partnered with Burundi on Global Health Security (GHS) since 2023



Burundi conducted a Joint External Evaluation (JEE) in 2018 and a follow-up in 2023.

The U.S. Government (USG) GHS Program in Burundi

The U.S. partners with the Government of Burundi to strengthen capacities to prevent, detect, and respond to infectious disease threats.

USG’s Global Health Security investments also support stronger, more resilient health systems, including training human and animal health workers, strengthening laboratories, and bolstering surveillance systems. These investments support and build on those made by the Government of Burundi, in coordination with other partners and stakeholders.

Current and planned GHS activities reflect national priorities, build on best available data, and align with the country context and the health system.
