## The U.S. Government (USG) GHS Program in the Dominican Republic

The U.S. partners with the Government of the Dominican Republic to strengthen capacities to prevent, detect, and respond to infectious disease threats. Areas of collaboration include strengthening zoonotic disease detection and response, biosafety and biosecurity, national laboratory systems, disease surveillance, health emergency management, and infection prevention and control.

U.S. investments support and build on those made by the Government of the Dominican Republic, in coordination with other partners and stakeholders. Current and planned GHS activities reflect national priorities, utilize the best available data, and align with the country context and the health system.
