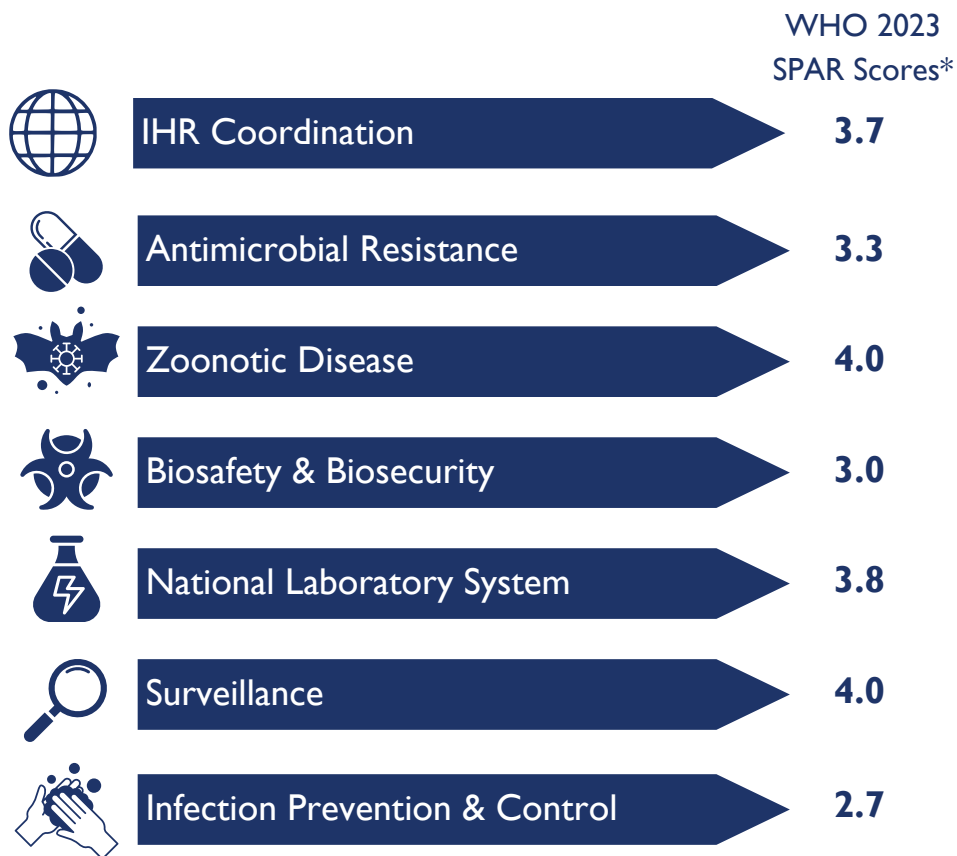

Technical Areas Endorsed by the Government of Jordan for U.S. Global Health Security Investments



* The World Health Organization (WHO) States Parties Annual Report (SPAR) is a publicly available self-assessment by the government of its global health security capacities. Scores presented here are based on a 5-point scale. Biosafety & Biosecurity score presented separately from National Laboratory System score. Antimicrobial Resistance uses [2021 Global Health Security Index](#) score as it is not included in the SPAR.



The U.S. has partnered with Jordan on Global Health Security (GHS) since 2023



Jordan conducted a Joint External Evaluation (JEE) in 2016 and a follow-up is planned for 2024.

The U.S. Government (USG) GHS Program in Jordan

The U.S. partners with the Government of Jordan to strengthen capacities to prevent, detect, and respond to infectious disease threats. Areas of collaboration include strengthening International Health Regulations coordination, antimicrobial resistance prevention, zoonotic disease detection and response, biosafety and biosecurity, national laboratory systems, disease surveillance, and infection prevention and control.

U.S. investments support and build on those made by the Government of Jordan, in coordination with other partners and stakeholders. Current and planned GHS activities reflect national priorities, utilize the best available data, and align with the country context and the health system.
