## The U.S. Government (USG) GHS Program in South Sudan

The U.S. partners with the Government of South Sudan to strengthen capacities to prevent, detect, and respond to infectious disease threats. Areas of collaboration include zoonotic disease detection and response, national laboratory systems, disease surveillance, human resources, health emergency management, and infection prevention and control.

U.S. investments support and build on those made by the Government of South Sudan in coordination with other partners and stakeholders. Current and planned GHS activities reflect national priorities, utilize the best available data, and align with the country context and the health system.
