## Technical Areas Endorsed by the Government of Uzbekistan for U.S. Global Health Security Investments



\* The World Health Organization (WHO) States Parties Annual Report (SPAR) is a publicly available self-assessment by the government of its global health security capacities. Scores presented here are based on a 5-point scale. Biosafety & Biosecurity score presented separately from National Laboratory System score. Antimicrobial Resistance uses [2021 Global Health Security Index](#) score as it is not included in the SPAR.

## The U.S. Government (USG) GHS Program in Uzbekistan

The U.S. partners with the Government of Uzbekistan to strengthen capacities to prevent, detect, and respond to infectious disease threats. Areas of collaboration include strengthening legal instruments, financing, antimicrobial resistance prevention, zoonotic disease detection and response, biosafety and biosecurity, laboratory systems, disease surveillance, human resources, health emergency management, and risk communication and community engagement.

U.S. investments support and build on those made by the Government of Uzbekistan, in coordination with other partners and stakeholders. Current and planned GHS activities reflect national priorities, utilize the best available data, and align with the country context and the health system.
