### Updated USCIS Form I-765 and I-566 for Employment Authorization Applications

The Office of Foreign Missions (OFM) informs missions that the Department of Homeland Security (DHS), United States Citizenship and Immigration Services (USCIS) has released updated editions of forms I-765 and I-566, Application for Employment Authorization. The updated edition's date is listed in MM/DD/YY format at the bottom of the forms. USCIS advises that the previous edition of form I-765, dated 10/31/2022, and I-566 form dated 12/02/21, **will not be accepted after June 3, 2024**. Therefore, OFM will no longer accept the previous edition of form I-765, dated 10/31/2022, and I-566 form dated 12/02/21, for Dependent Work Authorization applications after June 3, 2024.
