Hurricane Milton

According to the National Hurricane Center (NHC), Hurricane Milton is expected to grow in size and remain an extremely dangerous hurricane when it approaches the west coast of Florida Wednesday. Areas of heavy rainfall will impact portions of Florida today well ahead of Milton, with heavy rainfall more directly related to the system expected later today through Wednesday night. This rainfall will bring the risk of considerable flash, urban, and area flooding, along with the potential to moderate to major river flooding. Federal officials are working with officials from Florida as it stands in the path of Hurricane Milton and will support restoration efforts as soon as it is safe to do so.
